Community Based Contracts | Overview of Scope of Work*

Awardees will support Uplift in reaching out to disinvested communities to gather information about barriers and opportunities for local economic development that will be part of the Strategic Plan.



Conduct General Outreach & Engagement

- Gather demographic information to help describe and represent community members
- Distribute project information
- Conduct other engagement activities (e.g., surveys, canvassing, outreach, etc.)



Host Community Roundtables & Listening Sessions

- Engage community members to participate in in-depth conversations about the local economy and how it affects their lives
- Attend facilitation training hosted by Uplift
- Support eligible participants requesting inclusivity funding



Socialize Findings for Uplift Reports, Meetings & Final Strategic Plan

- Share findings with community members and organizations you collaborate with
- Collect input about the learnings to create shared ownership and honor community time & input
- Share Uplift content and opportunities with the community



Coordinate with the Uplift Project Team

- Propose to Uplift the type and nature of convenings, including number of community members you intend to reach
- Monthly check-in with Uplift Project Team to discuss achievements and potential challenges
- Produce report summarizing findings, methods used, etc.
- Develop presentation about findings







Community Based Contracts | Structure

Through CERF, Uplift will award a total of 30 contracts of \$15,000 each to selected Community Based Organizations (CBOs) for core general operating support. To ensure regional inclusivity, Uplift will award 15 contracts to each sub-region.

Scope

CBOs can use the funding to cover budgetary items such as:

- A percentage of staff salary
- Venue rentals
- Materials and supplies for listening session and community meeting presentations and facilitation
- Marketing materials
- Interpretation services
- Refreshments when required for listening sessions and community convenings
- Small purchases of technical equipment (laptop, projector, screen, etc.)

Community Based Contracts | Selection Process

Applications will be reviewed and selected by Uplift's Regional Steering Committee, which is representative of CERF's stakeholder groups and both sub-regions.

Regional Steering Committee

- The Regional Steering Committee is comprised of two Sub-Regional Steering Committees that convene monthly and include representatives across all 12 CERF stakeholder groups*.
- Nominations were solicited from the public and 24 members were selected by the Vision Committee using a process that sought to ensure diverse representation across the region and our communities.

Contract Selection Process**

- The Regional Steering Committee will review applications and select the awardees using a fair and equitable voting process.
- Applications will be evaluated on criteria not limited to proven experience, staff capacity to work within the project timeline, geographic scope, bilingual staff or capabilities, and more.
